

General Criteria for written material Cemus courses

These criteria distinguish a well written text and are useful for you in your writing process.

(1) *Understanding*. Are there any obvious misinterpretations of the literature or central arguments in the paper?

(2) *Completeness*. Are any of the central and relevant views/perspectives/standpoints in the literature left out in the paper without obvious reasons? Does the student answer the questions fully?

(3) *Literature*. Is there a lack of relevant references to the literature in the paper? Is it possible to assess whether or not the student has read and assimilated the literature?

(4) *Precision/clarity*. Is the paper comprehensible, well structured, precise and easy to follow?

(5) *Argumentation*. Does the student argue well for his/her own viewpoints?
