

Instructions writing of Assignment 2

You will write your own instructions for your Assignment 2 - This is an important learning objective in itself. At the seminar on March 13th you will be given some time to start your process of writing the assignment instructions. The instructions should, when finished, be OK:ed by me. Send your instructions via e-mail to me, deadline March 30th (but you can of course send them before that).

You can work in group, or individually. You can for instance create some kind of mini-internship; do a study-trip, an art-project, a pamphlet, an installation, interviews, something connected to a local or global context. The sky (and the instructions☺) is the limit! Be sure to think through how the instructions connect to the overall goals of the course.

The **instructions** should contain, but not be limited to:

1. Description of what you will do and with whom
2. A time plan
3. A clear, brief description of how the assignment and what you are planning on working on, connects to the following course goals:

After finishing the course the student shall:

be able to show cross disciplinary understanding of different views of Sustainable development and different ideologies in the field of environment and development;

be able to critically analyse controversies, similarities and disagreements in the sustainability debate by deriving different standpoints from presumptions and views on humans, nature, development, technology and economy;

have developed a personal attitude towards his/her own role regarding causes and solutions in the field of Sustainable development.

4. Include how the assignment will be presented (art, theater, poster, presentation, pictures etc.). All assignments should be presented in some way at the end of the course conference May 28th. Maximum 20 minutes for a group and 15 for an individual.

In addition to presenting your work (the actual work, not the instructions) at the conference, you also need to turn in an individual written part of minimum 800 words, where you reflect on how the work went and how you assess your work in relation to your own instructions. Here you should also reference to at least 1 article or book. This reflection should be of academic quality. Deadline is May 28th (upload to studentportalen).
