Instructions Final Presentation

The presentations of your final projects will take place in Frödingssalen, where you will have access to a computer with Internet, sound equipment and projector, if wanted. Every group will have around 20 minutes to present their project. There will also be some extra time for questions.

While preparing for the presentation, try to add something from every part of your process. Although, the main part of your presentation should be focused on the design. Also make sure that *all* members of the group are active in the presentation. For example you can include discussions about:

Step 1 - Goals Articulation

- What vision, goals and stakeholders were included in your first goals articulation? Did it change during the process – if so, how and why?

Step 2 - Observation and Analysis

- How did you do your observation, and what have you observed?
- How did you use your observations in your design?

Step 3 - Design

- What does your final design looks like?
- What people will be involved?
- How will it function during various points in the year?
- What permaculture principles have you used in your design?
- What resources will be needed and where can they be obtained?
- Have you noticed any problems in your design?

When all groups have presented their projects, we will have a potluck lunch close to the area of your design. During/after the lunch, we will have the opportunity to discuss your different designs and visualize how they could be implemented on the area.
