Feel free to connect *Getting to Maybe* to other literature and sources to bring to light interesting connections. Have a look at other book reviews for inspiration.

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### **Comparative essay (300-400 words)**

Pick an article from the course reader that you were particularly interested in. What do the authors say about how change happens? Compare and contrast to a different article or a video lecture. What can you learn from these sources?
